

INFORMATION SHEET IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF REGULATION (EU) NO. 679/2016

1. Identity and contact details of the Owner

The Owner of the personal data is the Standing Committee of the Ski Meeting Interbancario Europeo with seat in Italy, 37121 Verona, Vicolo Due Mori 5/A, at Circolo Unicredit Verona, e-mail info@skimeetinginterbancario.org.

2. Description of the processing, its finalities and legal basis

Personal data of people who register and participate voluntarily in the event "Ski Meeting Interbancario Europeo" are processed.

Identifying personal data, contact details, information on the team to which they belong are processed.

Images, portraits and recordings of the interested parties are also processed, as the Committee collects photographic and audio-visual recordings of the Event, which necessarily include images, portraits and sounds attributable to the natural persons of the participants. Participants can be captured in group scenes or in the background, but also with recordings in which the people portrayed are recognizable and identifiable.

The legal basis for the treatment is:

- The treatment is necessary for the execution of a contract stipulated with the local Organizing Committee of which the person concerned is an indirectly interested party or for the execution of pre-contractual measures" (art. 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679);
- the processing is necessary to fulfil a legal obligation (art. 6 paragraph 1 letter c) of Reg. (EU) 2016/679
- the consent of the person concerned, when necessary.

Personal data are processed exclusively:

- for the purpose of ensuring the execution of the Event and the participation of the person concerned, by executing the registration to the event, exercising the rights and fulfilling the obligations related;
- limited to the data of the participants connected to the participation and to the results of the competitions and to those contained in the images or recordings, for the purpose of documenting and disseminating knowledge of the Event and the activities of the Committee.

-3. Recipients of personal data

Personal data are communicated to third parties in compliance with legal obligations, regulations or measures of the authorities, or where it is necessary to pursue the purposes mentioned above.

The personal data processed by the Owner may be communicated to auxiliaries of the Owner who perform activities necessary to achieve the above purposes, including:

- persons acting under the authority of the Owner pursuant to Article 29 of Regulation (EU) No. 679/2016
- external parties who provide the Owner with services (for example, logistics, photography, etc...) chosen among suppliers of proven reliability and who provide appropriate guarantees in accordance with the provisions of Article 28 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016.

4. Dissemination of personal data

For the purposes described above, personal information related to the races (such as participants, results achieved by participants, prizewinners), images and footage of the Event may be reproduced, processed, distributed, disseminated and communicated to the public by any means - including, but not limited to, websites, social media, DVDs - in any subjective and territorial, including worldwide, context.

5. Period of retention of personal data

Personal data processed for the purposes of historical documentation of the Event (such as, but not limited to, photographic or audio-visual documentation of the races or other moments of the event, the compositions of the teams, the results of the races ...) are permanently acquired in the historical archive of the Owner and processed in the manner described above without time limits.

6. Rights of the interested party

Pursuant to Article 13(2)(b), (c) and (d) and Articles 16 to 21 of Regulation (EU) No 679/2016, the person concerned has the right:

- to ask the Owner for access to personal data and the rectification or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the processing that concerns him or to refuse their processing;
- if the processing is based on consent, to revoke the consent at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on consent until revocation;
- to make a complaint to the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data or take other remedies to protect the data in accordance with current legislation.
